## Eligibility and Restrictions:

- Applicants must be enrolled as a graduate student or are alumni of a graduate program in conflict resolution or peacebuilding at Columbia University or any university around the globe.
- Each scholarship is worth \$2,000, and recipients are required to spend these monies to cover travel to and from the Learning Exchange; accommodation for up to 3 nights; registration and CMM membership.

Applications require a proposal describing a study or project and how CMM was used. Proposals can be focused on research, practice or appliced research.
